

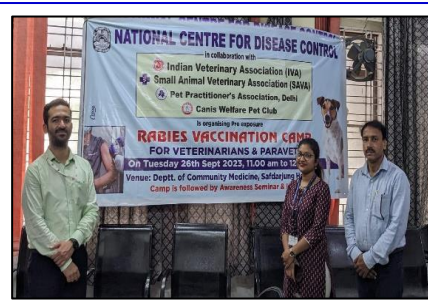
Summary report on activities done so far at National Level on “World Rabies Day 2023”

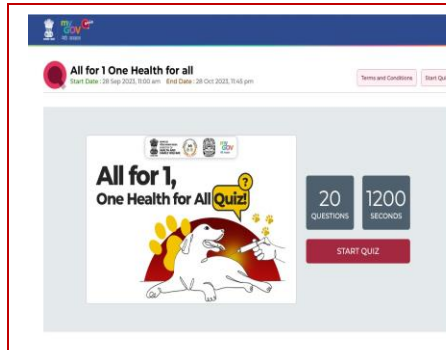

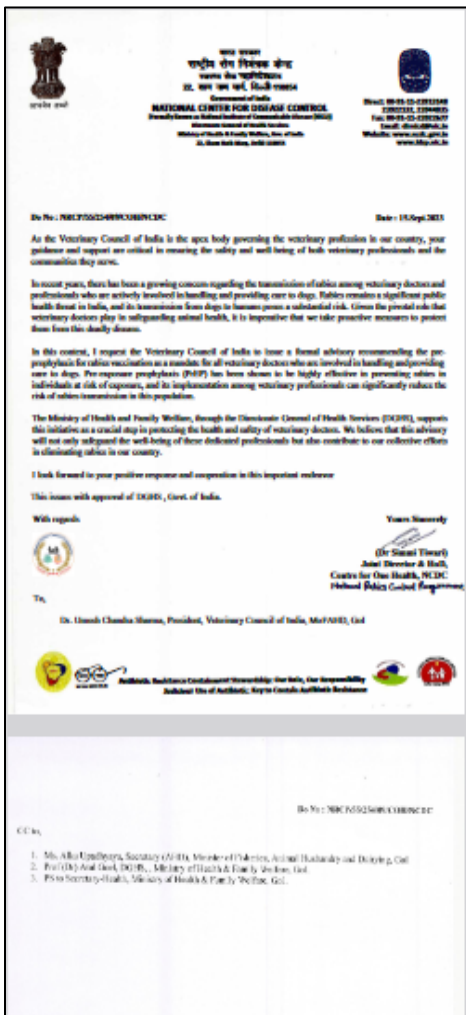


8. Twitter messages were prepared by the program division on Rabies. Which have been twit on twitter by the MoHFW on the occasion of World Rabies Day 2023.
